The Vota Book Fund Scholarship is designed to provide financial assistance to qualifying Vermont residents attending an accredited master of occupational therapy program or first two years of a COTA program with the purchasing of academic books.

Scholarship Awards

The scholarship award includes \$500.00 for the academic calendar year (2018-2019). One applicant is to be awarded the scholarship. The scholarship money is to be used specifically to purchase books required and recommended by the occupational therapy program. The scholarship is awarded on a yearly basis and is not renewable.

- Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited occupational therapy program, be enrolled in a graduate degree program or first/second year for a COTA program.
